

## **BASIC CERTIFICATE COURSE IN** EARLY PREGNANCY MANAGEMENT FOR NURSES

The Basic Course in Early Pregnancy Management for Nurses aims to help practising nurses in Asia-Pacific region to be updated on management of common problems encountered during early pregnancy. Specifically, it will help nurses working in IVF units understand how these problems are managed nowadays, how these problems may affect the monitoring of pregnancy arising from assisted conception, and the extra care required for women who are at risk of these complications.
